## **BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma in Performing Arts (Dance)**

The BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma is a vocational qualification taken in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. The qualification is organised and awarded by the Edexcel within the BTEC brand and it is equivalent to A-Levels. It is regarded as equivalent in level to the GCE A Levels, more specifically to three A2 awards and the AVCE (Advanced Vocational Certificate of Education).

## **Subjects Studied**

Along side compulsory units in Dance Performance and Performing Arts business, the Historical Context of Performance and Rehearsal there are a number of additional units that include:

- Classical ballet technique
- Contemporary dance technique
- Jazz dance
- Tap dance
- Urban dance
